Salvaged architectural antiques add vintage quality to any dwelling.

On the relatively youthful West Coast, architectural antiques are hard to come by—just ask those clamouring for the bricks recovered from the old Woodward's building. Scott Landon and Rob Thomson aim to change that with their new South Granville store Archetique, which reclaims 18th- and 19th-century Canadiana and Americana salvaged from points east: think doors with original brass, working latches and glass from Chicago circa 1900, or a 19th-century terracotta keystone that once witnessed many a goodnight kiss at the entrance of a New York apartment complex. —*Meaghan Ng*
